

Northern Sydney Health signs for THELMA

Health services group ICSGlobal Ltd has signed up a fourth New South Wales Area Health service to use THELMA.

Northern Sydney Area Health Service (Northern Sydney Health), which represents approximately 9% of the NSW public health system, has signed a three year THELMA User Agreement for electronic processing of patient eligibility checks, hospital claims and medical claims.

Northern Sydney Health provides health services through Hornsby Ku-ring-gai Hospital and Community Health Services; Manly and Mona Vale Hospitals and Community Health Services; Royal North Shore Hospital and Community Health Services; Ryde Hospital and Community Health Services; Northern Sydney Home Nursing Service; Northern Sydney Mental Health Service incorporating Macquarie Hospital; Northern Sydney Health Dental Services. Affiliated organisations are the Royal Rehabilitation Centre Sydney and Hope Healthcare: Neringah Hospital, Greenwich Hospital and Graythwaite Nursing Home.

Northern Sydney Health joins three other NSW Area health services - South East Health, Western Area Health and Illawarra Area Health – to take THELMA's coverage of the NSW public health system to 31%.
