Thelma-US partners with Revenue Management Solutions

ICSGlobal Limited, an eHealth company listed on the Australian Stock Exchange, today announced that its US subsidiary Thelma-US, Inc. has reached agreement with Revenue Management Solutions, L.L.C. (**'RMS'**) for the interchange of electronic revenue cycle management transactions between banks, healthcare providers and healthcare payers across the US.

The President and CEO of Thelma-US, Mr BP Fulmer, said the RMS relationship is the second of three key connectivity partnerships to get the Thelma medical banking clearinghouse platform established in the US market.

"This latest strategic partnership gives us immediate access to the electronic revenue cycle management transactions that generate the value from vertically integrating Thelma with the medical billing companies we plan to acquire," said Mr. Fulmer.

"It also complements the recently announced strategic relationship Thelma-US struck with MedData that gives us connectivity for real time eligibility data from more than 350 of the largest commercial and government (Medicare and Medicaid) payers in the US market," he added.

"Through these strategic connectivity relationships, and the unique capabilities of the Thelma transaction management and routing platform, Thelma-US is quickly establishing one of the most comprehensive medical banking offerings available in the US market today," Mr Fulmer said.

Based in Oklahoma, RMS provides a range of specialised revenue cycle management transactions and services between banks, healthcare providers and healthcare payers that can significantly increase margins for healthcare providers and billing companies. Its core platform, MEDRx, converts the paper-based explanation of benefits (EOBs) provided by healthcare payers into electronic transactions that enables RMS to perform remittance advice consolidation, denial management, secondary claims filing, automated claims-to-payments reconciliation, and an online archive of a provider's payment records. Thelma-US will become a reseller of RMS transactions and services.

The Chief Executive Officer of RMS, Tom Dean, said; "We are delighted that Thelma-US is connecting to our MEDRx platform. The business model that Thelma-US has adopted is of great interest to us as there is enormous opportunity in the US for a configurable eHealth transaction routing platform that can handle administrative as well as clinical transactions. An immediate target market for Thelma-US is the medical billing company market, which has been underserved and over charged by the large established transaction services providers."

Tim Murray, the CEO of ICSGlobal Ltd, the parent company of Thelma-US, said the US strategy is on track.

"As soon as we get connected to RMS, Thelma-US has a powerful set of revenue cycle management services that we can market to the more than 3,500 medical billing companies in the US which currently provide services to approximately 35% of the healthcare provider market. This is in addition to eligibility requests and responses from MedData, and we're at contracts stage for the third connectivity partnership which will give us electronic claims clearing access to over 800 payers," Mr Murray said.
