UK Update

Release 1 of eCABS (electronic Claims and Billing System) for the UK is in testing, and rollout is scheduled to commence next month, not in June as stated in the Business Update released by ICS in March.

The reason for the delay is additional functionality in Release 1, as requested by MackenzieHealth Limited (MHL). This in turn has expanded the amount of software that ICSGlobal has had to develop, which MHL is paying for. The result will be that Release 1 of eCABS will have a much more comprehensive range of features, functions and benefits than originally envisaged.

MHL have continued to develop the UK market in parallel with the development of Release 1, and report keen interest from consultants and health insurers ahead of the system going live.

Further details of the UK, together with a full update of the THELMA business in Australia and internationally, will be provided in a Letter to Shareholders later this month.
