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## THELMA and US-based ADSR to Combine Technologies

The HRCP solution is based upon a powerful patent pending process that provides comprehensive patient information verification for the healthcare industry, combating fraud and facilitating credit transactions between businesses and consumers to help healthcare providers and ancillary facilities realize improved cash flow and make informed business decisions. ADSR's products have the ability to utilise time-of-service payment options such as credit cards including credit card authorisation forms, E-Pay Virtual Terminal credit card payment system, and bank loan program (full or non-recourse) to increase collections and reduce bad debt.

The President of ADSR, Phillip R. Dolamore, said that THELMA seems to perfectly complement ADSR's product offering.

"A real time eligibility check to health insurers is a key piece of the jigsaw that we're looking for right now in our product offering, and rather than reinvent the wheel it makes sense to go with a proven system like THELMA. We expect this prototype will quickly sort out the best way to combine the technologies, and we'd be looking to go into rollout mode as soon as we can after that" said Mr Dolamore.
